

On February 11, 2021, the Bushland ISD Board of Trustees voted unanimously to call a bond election for May 1, 2021. The bond package was developed and proposed by the district's Citizens Planning Committee, a facilities planning committee made up of local citizens.

The bond package, totaling \$94.3 million, addresses rapid growth in the district as well as increased safety and aging conditions of facilities.

The following projects will address current overcrowding in our schools and accommodate the continued enrollment growth projected at all grade levels over the next 10 years.

NEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL: \$25.2 MILLION

Serving grades PK-2, 500 student capacity with 750 core capacity for future expansion To be built on a new site (TBD)

NEW HIGH SCHOOL: \$61.6 MILLION

Serving grades 9-12, 600 student capacity with 750 core capacity for future expansion To be built on the existing high school property (adjacent to the current facility)

The following projects will address increased safety measures and aging conditions at existing schools:

\$6 MILLION

(to become an additional Elementary School, grades 3–5)

- Safety & Security
 - Secure Entry Vestibule
 - Improved Exterior Lighting
- New Public Address (PA) System
- Plumbing and Electrical System Upgrades
- ADA (Handicapped Accessibility) Upgrades
- New Fire Alarm
- Interior Renovations
- Add Playground

EXISTING MIDDLE SCHOOL RENOVATIONS: EXISTING HIGH SCHOOL RENOVATIONS: \$1.5 MILLION

(to become the Middle School serving grades 6–8)

- Safety & Security
 - Secure Entry Vestibule
 - Improved Exterior Lighting
- Install Exterior Bell System
- Convert Existing Ag Welding Shop to Wood Shop with Added Ventilation
- Improve Site Draining at Falcon Entry

*Project budgets represent a "turn-key" amount, which includes estimated construction cost, escalation due to inflation, fees, permits, furniture, and equipment.

Should the bond proposal be approved by voters, the estimated maximum tax impact of the bond proposal is .2275 cents for a total tax rate of \$1.3876. For the average BISD home value of approximately \$300,000, this represents an increase of \$52.14 per month.

CITIZENS 65 & OLDER HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION

According to state law, the dollar amount of school taxes imposed on the residence homestead of a person 65 years of age or older cannot be increased above the amount paid in the first year after the person turned 65, regardless of changes in tax rate or property value unless significant improvements are made to the home. If you are 65 or older, you may file a homestead application at any time, or contact your appraisal district to see if you already have the appropriate exemption on file.



In the next five years, Bushland ISD's total enrollment is expected to surpass 1,700 students with an additional 325 students, which is approx. 14 classrooms.

In 2020, BISD experienced the highest number of new home sales recorded in the last 10 years. There are currently nearly 500 vacant developed lots and 500 future planned lots throughout the district.
